- All students must be independent, fully potty trained.

3 YEAR OLD CLASS

Age 3 by Dec. 31

Designed to strengthen a child's understanding of themselves, the world around them, and the structure and routine of early classroom learning.

4 YEAR OLD CLASS

Age 4 by Dec. 31

Classroom activities are planned to help develop self-esteem, self-control, creativity, social skills, and early academics.

MWF OR T/Th OR MTWThF 8:45 AM - 11:30 AM OR 12:30 PM - 3:15 PM

PRE-K CLASS

Age 4 by Sept. 1

An extended day where students will learn through a variety of play opportunities and that their social learning is equally as vital as their academic learning.

MWF OR MTWThF 8:45 AM - 12:30 PM

YOUNG 5'S *

Turning 5 Sept. 1 to Dec. 31 Extended day preschool play-based program designed for students to develop academically, socially, and emotionally prior to experiencing a traditional kindergarten program.

M/T/Th/F 8:45 AM - 1:30 PM

3 YEAR OLD CLASS

The incoming student has a sense of structure and routine at home and is developmentally ready to follow basic direction from adults.

Academic Goals for the Year

- Help students adjust to a structured, school environment
- Arm students with basic foundational fine motor skills for older classes/further learning
- Expose students to Pre-reading, Pre-writing & Foundational Math Skills
- Guide students to a better understanding of self, and their place in a group setting

4 YEAR OLD CLASS

The incoming student has a sense of structure and routine at home and is developmentally ready to follow basic direction from adults.

Academic Goals for the Year

- Effectively communicate wants & needs
- Work on fine motor skills through drawing, cutting, name writing, creative art and manipulatives
- Introduction to lowercase letters and their sounds using ZooPhonics
- Building on foundational math skills

PRE-K CLASS

Incoming students can independently use simple classroom materials, sustain longer attention with classroom activities individually & in small groups and are able to transition easily throughout the classroom in small groups.

- Extra time to grow & develop socially & academically
- Continued work in letter/sound recognition
- Math readiness with numbers 0-20 & patterns
- · First & last name writing
- Eats lunch while at school

YOUNG 5'S

Priority will be given to students who turn 5 between
September 1st and December 1st.
Must have previous preschool experience

Academic Goals for the Year

- Intense focus and review of Zoophonics sounds & letters
- Identify names of upper & lowercase letters & connects them to sounds
- Read & write first and last name
- Introduction to beginning sight words
- Engage in weekly journaling, using pictures & labels to tell a story
- Continued math skills
- Eats lunch while at school
