








Children's Ministry Right Now Media Pick of the Month


This month's Kids Pick of the Month is:

We acted out standing on the Areopagus and imagined what it was like for Paul to look around at all the false gods. Just like Paul, we talked about how even though we know God's love, there are many people around us who don't know Him yet.

The big takeaway for the children was:

We know the one true God, and we can share His love with others, just like Paul did!

You can ask your child:

- What did Paul see when he walked around Athens?
- What did he say about the one true God?
- How can we show God's love to someone who doesn't know Him?
