We have built and steward affordable senior housing through Liberty Tambo Apartments and the Read Center. We have continuously collected, donated, and prayed for different organizations around the globe.

Over the last six years we have partnered with five different organizations and ministries, walking with them more closely than others. Those are Ray of Hope and Iglesias del Oeste ministries in Uganda and Mexico who are taking the gospel to communities that have never heard of Jesus. Show Me Christian Youth Home who rescues children from the foster care system and helps raise these children in a Christian community. We partner with Retrieving Freedom and Veterans Community Project in support of our veterans. We partner with the staff and students at Washington Elementary in their pursuit of supporting at-risk children. We do so much and I'm proud to serve a congregation that values serving.

Along with our partnerships and service to the community we have gone on countless mission trips over the years. These have benefited the communities we have served, but also everyone who has gone on one has been impacted. Because of the impact mission trips have, we are striving to provide several affordable and exciting opportunities to go serve on a mission trip this year.

In March we will be heading to Christmount to serve a community affected by flooding from the East Coast hurricanes.

This summer our youth will be heading to Colorado to serve communities in need.

In late August and early September we will be heading to Uganda to serve communities who need love and support.

We will also be having a weekend trip to St. Louis to help build a tiny home for the veteran community there.




Animated adventures little children love with
