- Promote discipleship as a pathway towards Christ-like maturity for all members
- Beyond the discipleship pathway, develop a step-by-step playbook to help our members mature in their faith
- Ensure ministry staff devote themselves to spiritually guiding members on the pathway

- Develop Leadership Plus which aims to develop leaders into spiritual guides
- Offer regular spiritual growth opportunities online - Podcasts, Videos, Bible Studies
- Offer activities that foster the use of the Prayer Chapel and encourage a deep prayer life
- Continue our commitment to Children’s Ministry and Youth Ministry
- Develop a ministry that serves the needs of recent high school graduates



- Develop a team that helps our church embrace growth
 - This team will evaluate ministries and recommend a duplication process.
 - Develop a Property Utilization Plan that helps us best understand how to use our facility most effectively - including Sunday mornings and other key times

- Creatively staff to meet our current needs and staff for continued growth - Admin, Student Ministry, Clergy, etc.
- Form a formal Security Team in the first year of this vision



- Create at least one new Sunday Morning small group (Sunday School/Bible study)
- Relaunch the Membership team to include a plan to care for and nurture new members
- Nurture new members by guiding them to environments of connection (landing spots)
- Within the first year of membership improve assimilation of new members.
- Seek new and creative ways to serve our current membership and foster connection - local, online, and distant
- Embrace the continued emergence of new small groups
- Establish within every small group these values and expectations:
 - True Community/Fellowship
 - Deep Christian Spirituality
 - Opportunities to serve
- Encourage the Fellowship Ministry Team to offer new opportunities for gathering
- Continued commitment to the ministry of the 55+ Club
- Encourage the use of Church Center as our primary source of communication
 - Membership Directory, Giving, Sign-ups, Calendar, Service Planning, Guest Sign-In
- Develop solid guest processes and appropriate follow up plan
- Refresh gathering area and create a Welcome Center



- Maintain outreach and mission as a pillar of our identity
- Consider a tangible way to serve the people struggling with housing insecurity in Sedalia
- Promote the continued use of our facility in outreach efforts
- Host a Mission Week in Sedalia every year
- Create one local ministry that we steward
- Find creative ways to partner with the outreach efforts of our small groups
- Evaluate our mission partnerships and determine if they are providing the most meaningful opportunities for our congregation to serve
- Welcome opportunities to develop a local multi-lingual connection
- Financially support the Mid-America Region and the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)
- Ensure that we offer at least one youth and one general mission trip per year
- Disciple/Mentor one nearby congregation
