If you missed the capital campaign presentation on Sunday in worship, I would encourage you to find our worship service online and watch it again. One of our elders spoke genuinely about his excitement, and he gave us insight into his understanding of giving. When elders speak in church, I listen carefully! They are our spiritual leaders and they don't speak lightly. I thought he did a really nice job of inviting us to consider giving to the new capital campaign to help pay for the new addition to our church.

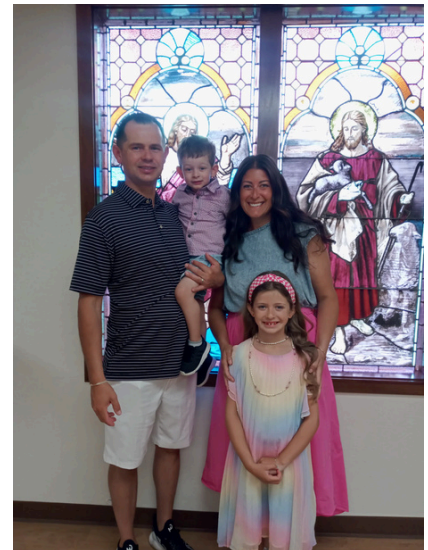

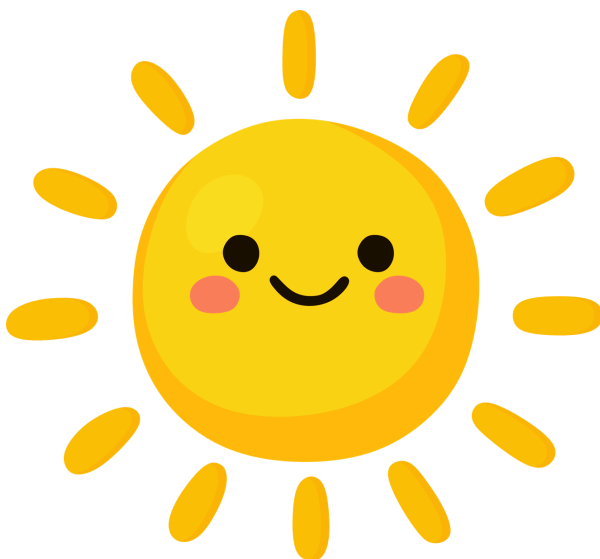

Sunday we learned about Noah sending out the raven and the dove while waiting for the floodwaters to go down (Genesis 8:6-12). Noah had been on the ark for a long time and didn't know exactly when it would be safe to leave. He had to wait and trust that God was taking care of him.

The dove eventually returned with an olive leaf, showing that new life was growing and that God was keeping His promise. We talked about how waiting can be hard, but God is with us even when we can't see what He is doing.

Our big lesson today was:

We can trust God while we wait!

- 1. What did the dove bring back to Noah, and why was that exciting?**
- 2. What is something you're waiting for right now, and how can you remember to trust God while you wait?**
