Expectations

Serve Areas

These are the serve areas that are available to SLS students:

- **Kids Classroom Volunteer.** If you love kids o through 5th grade then this is the choice for you! You will learn to teach kids, play games, and love on kids in the class!
- **Kids Check-Ins.** Check-ins are designed to keep our kids safe. As a check-in volunteer you will check in kids, show them to their classrooms, and run the Prize Counter!
- **Kids Sound Booth.** Do you love to help with sound, media, and lights?
- **Student Leader.** This is an option for students who want to help run services for Momentum. Whether that is being a small

- group leader to younger students, running the sound booth, posting on the instagram, running a game, or speaking.
- **Production Tech Team.** If you are creative and have a desire to express yourself through the Arts and Technology, then this team will fulfill those outlets. Paint the room with light, fill the room with music, feel the bass flow! Create video elements, light shows, live streams, podcasts, and music mixes. Show people The Gospel through all the most creative avenues available.
- **Worship Volunteer.** This is for any student interested in being apart of the music team for our weekend experience ministry. We're looking for vocalists, guitarist, pianist, bassist, and drummers, so if you're passionate about musical arts and advancing the gospel through song, we'd love for you to be apart of this team.

Once a Month Training

Once a month training is a time for students to grow. During that time we will have a lot of fun by studying the Bible, learning leadership qualities, serving our community, and building relationships with one another. Bring your Bible and a notebook to take notes with. All campuses will meet at the central location in Sherwood, Arkansas.

You can only miss one once a month training during a single semester. Missing more than that will result in a meeting with the parent and possible failure for the semester.

Disciplinary Actions

If an issue arises and disciplinary action must be taken, it will be up to the Student Pastor on the level of action taken. After 2 disciplinary actions during one semester, the student will be removed from SLS for the remainder of that semester. All Corrective Action Statements will be documented and signed by the Student Pastor, student, and parent. If any additional actions are required it will be up to the student to ensure they are met within the guidelines and date set on the Corrective Action Statement. If the student fails to comply or meet the guidelines set they will be removed from SLS for the remainder of the semester.
