Summary:

The Worship Pastor at Fairfield Christian Church will work closely with the Senior Pastor and staff to craft worship services and other events that engage and encourage people to experience Jesus in a fresh way.

Personal Qualifications:

- A self-motivated person with a desire to continue to grow in ability to lead their team, both biblically and musically
- Full-time experience leading a worship team in a church setting, managing people, and working with a staff team to fulfill the church's vision
- Theological beliefs that align with Fairfield Christian Church's statement of belief as found on our website

Worship Duties:

- Lead all aspects of planning and coordinating main worship service, including effective worship practices
- Engage and lead church to be moved to worship in main services and other worship events
- Utilize creative elements in service, in partnership with Creative Team, to create an environment that fulfills the vision of the church
- Provide pastoral care to your worship team members

Organizational Duties:

- Recruit, train and schedule volunteer musicians and tech crew to maximize potential of each volunteer
- Build and maintain a library of current worship music that team can use to stay on trend for worship services
- Set goals and manage budget to meet said goals
- Oversee management of worship center and upkeep licenses such as CCLI

Staffing Responsibilities:

- Supervise tech director position and media director positions on staff
- Participate in weekly staff meetings, lead Creative Team and assist staff in providing care for the congregation
- Serve as point person work with directional team to execute special events
- Work alongside staff to build and maintain relationship with Fairfield Christian Academy
