IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- This event is designed to be an entry point for families in our community to see First NLR
 and experience the love of Jesus. No matter what job you have, you are making a lasting
 impact in the lives of families in our community.
- All volunteers should park at Central Baptist Church (at the corner of Somers and Fairway in the lot across the street from their building). There will be a shuttle to bring you to the church. If you need to return to your car, go to the shuttle stop under the front awning in Lot A and a shuttle will take you. Shuttles will run from 8am to 1pm.

 ***If you're on the Saturday Morning setup team, you can park in Lot A, come help set up, and then move your car at 9am to Central Baptist Church.
- When you arrive please proceed directly to the Main Awning to sign in and receive your nametag and instructions. Everyone must sign in and get a nametag before going to your assigned location.
- All volunteers need to be at their assigned location <u>NO LATER</u> than 30 minutes before your shift begins (9:30am). We recommend an hour before the event to park, sign in, and get to your location on time.
- Feel free to wear any First NLR apparel you have! Just be sure to dress comfortably for the weather and the work you'll be doing!
- If you work in Parking Services please sign in at Volunteer Central as well. There you will receive all the information you need plus your radio.
- We will have water at the event, but there will be no food.
- Childcare will NOT be provided during Egg-O-Rama.

Everything is Better in Teams!

Preschool Birth-2 Years Old Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Emilie Loy

Place 120 plastic eggs per hunt at various places in plain sight around the egg hunt area. Allow 8 kids at a time inside the egg hunt area. Allow parents/family to come inside to take pictures and escort their child as needed. Have one worker standing at the exit to "supplement" any child's basket that doesn't have many eggs, and to give each child one bag of Fruit Snacks and one bag of M&Ms as they leave.

Preschool 3-5 Years Old Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Emilie Loy

Place 388 plastic eggs per hunt at various places in plain sight around the egg hunt area. Allow 20 kids at a time inside the egg hunt area. Have them line up around the perimeter of the hunt. Encourage parents/family to stay outside the fenced in hunt area to take pictures. If the parent insists being inside to escort child, allow them. When you say, "Go," they may begin to run and pick up eggs. No pushing, shoving, or stealing. Whoever's hand touches the egg first is the winner of the egg. Have one worker standing at the exit to "supplement" any child's basket that doesn't have many eggs, and to give each child one bag of Fruit Snacks and one bag of M&Ms as they leave.

Special Needs Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Jennifer Nash

Place 200 plastic eggs per hunt at various places in plain sight around the egg hunt area. Allow 12-15 kids at a time inside the egg hunt area. Have them line around the perimeter of the hunt. Because of the nature of this egg hunt parents/family are encouraged to help their children as much as needed. They can assist their children or take pictures. When you say, "Go," they may begin to run and pick up eggs. No pushing, shoving, or stealing. Whoever's hand touches the egg first is the winner of the egg. Have one worker standing at the exit to "supplement" any child's basket that doesn't have many eggs, and to give each child one bag of Fruit Snacks and one bag of M&Ms as they leave.

Elementary K-5th Grade Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Pastor Tyler Loy

Place 375 plastic eggs per hunt at various places around the egg hunt area. Allow kids to hunt eggs and play in the MAC Party Zone area. No pushing, shoving, or stealing. Whoever's hand touches the egg first is the winner of the egg. Have one worker standing at the exit to give one bag of M/Ms and one bag of Skittles to each kid.

Elementary Egg Hunt / Bunny Photos Line Worker – Team Leader: Melody Jones

Workers will greet children and parents and direct them to the picture and/or egg hunt area. Some workers will assist by helping children get in place for the picture. You will be located across the portal, in the MAC exit lobby.

Bunny Photos Photographer – Team Leader: Aaron Stone

Take guests' picture with the Easter Bunny! You will be located across the portal in the Power Outlet area.

Bunny Photos Photographer Runners - Team Leader: Aaron Stone

Assist Bunny Photos Photographer and help families in and out of the room! Pass out slips of paper letting guests know where to get their photos online. You will be located across the portal in the Power Outlet.

Bunny Photos Character – Team Leader: Aaron Stone

Sit on the bench and pose with children for their photo. You will be located in either room 7, 8, 9, or 10 of the MAC.

Face Painting Line – Team Leader: Miranda Stone

Greet and assist kids/families in line and direct them to the face paint artists, as well as, helping them exit when finished. Keep the line moving as quickly as possible, but also, more importantly, make sure everyone is having a fun and exciting experience. You will be located next to the MAC building.

Face Painting Artist – Team Leader: Mackenzie Peirce

Paint on each child's face with a design according to the options given to you by the team leaders. You will be located next to the MAC building.

Preschool Inflatable – Team Leader: Shelby Thomas

Leader will allow 5 children age 5 and under in bounce house at a time - time limit of 5 minutes. All kids in the bounce house must remove their shoes before entering into the bounce house. Only ONE child at a time is allowed to slide.

Preschool Bounce House – Team Leader: Shelby Thomas

Leader will allow 5-7 children age 5 and under in bounce house at a time - time limit of 5 minutes. All kids in the bounce house must remove their shoes before entering into the bounce house.

Water Tents - Team Leaders: Dawson Walthall

Offer water to guests passing by. You should have two coolers of iced down water bottles. Smile and be friendly.

Elementary Obstacle Course – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

One worker stands at entrance instructing children 5th Grade and under (direct pre-school aged kids to the Preschool Lane) to remove their shoes and place to the right of the entrance in an orderly fashion. One worker should be at end of the obstacle course assisting children in exiting. Kids can pick up their shoes at the front of the obstacle course. *Parents can walk beside kids if needed.

Elementary Duel Slide Inflatable – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

Please have kids remove their shoes before entering the inflatable. 2 kids are allowed at a time to enter the slide. Once the kids are at the top and about to slide down, send 2 more. One worker needs to be standing next to the slide instructing kids to slide on their bottoms, feet first (NO JUMPING and NO FLIPS). This is for children 5th Grade and under (direct pre-school aged kids to the Preschool Lane).

Elementary Football Toss – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

Kids are able to toss a football straight toward a specific direction. Once the ball lands, mark it as the longest toss of the day until it is beaten by another throw. Allow kids 2 or 3 tosses based on the length of the line. There should be one or two leaders snagging the thrown balls and one or two leaders at the throwing line giving instructions.

Elementary Baggo Toss – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

Kids will throw baggo bags toward the baggo boards in an attempt to make the bags in the hole. They get 4 tosses. They get a piece of candy for every bag they make in the hole.

Elementary Chalk Area – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

We will have a large area where kids can draw with chalk. Please monitor and make sure they are not drawing or writing anything inappropriate. Let them have fun for a few minutes and switch them out based on the length of the line.

Parking Services / Shuttles – Team Leader: Pastor Layne Mason

Sign in at Volunteer Central under the main awning. You will receive instructions and your radio. Volunteers will direct parking and run shuttles.

Prize Registration Booths - Team Leaders: Pastor Shelby (Booths 1 & 2)

Have guests scan the QR code and fill out the form on their personal device. Doing so registers them for a \$250 Visa gift card. If they have issues with filling out the digital form, there are printed cards you can have them fill out with a pen. Collect the completed cards and pens and keep them in one of the small tubs at your booth. A runner will come and collect completed cards in tubs periodically throughout the event if you have any. Please use the QR codes first and only use the printouts if you have to. Please be available to answer questions they may have about the church and invite them to services this weekend.

Saturday Setup - Team Leader: Pastor Gary Tomlinson

Sign in at the MAIN ENTRANCE at 8am and then report to Pastor Gary Tomlinson at the HVKM AWNING for an assignment. Assignments will be given upon arrival. Some of the duties include transporting items, blowing up balloons, decorating, etc. We will work until everything is ready for the event. (Park in Lot A while you set up, but please don't forget to move your vehicle to Central Baptist Church no later than 9am. In case there is still work to be done at that time, please check with Pastor Gary after you move your vehicle.)

Welcome Team - Team Leaders: Sharon Hall

You will be stationed at the entrance of the event and greet people as they get off the shuttle. You have one of the most important jobs because you will make one of the first impressions people receive. Be friendly, smile, and help answer any questions guests may have.

Cleaning Team - Team Leader: Pastor Randy Jumper

Walk through assigned areas picking up trash, emptying and replacing trash bags, etc. Cleaning supplies will be located on Lot C's side of the MAC by the stairs where the music is playing. Trash bags should be brought to the dumpster. Help make sure all areas look clean.

Lost & Found – Team Leader: Kathy Brockinton

Help police officers with lost children and missing items.

Finishers (Tear Down)

Sign in at the MAIN AWNING no later than 11:30am and then report to your Finishers Team Leader (below) at your assigned location (below) to receive your first assignment. If you are already serving at the event, then check with your Team Leader as soon as your area shuts down. Follow instructions given by your team leader to place all items in their proper place. Stick around until we're finished and the campus is ready for our first Easter service of the weekend that Saturday night at 5pm!
