From the Pastor's Desk

"Tell me what it is you plan to do with you one Wild and Precious Life?"
-The Summer Day, by Mary Oliver

This is a cherished line from a favorite poem of mine. This lofty question is the final line of the poem which opens with the equally loft line: "Who made the world?"

But between these grandiose questions are the detailed descriptions of a grasshopper. How she moves her jaw back and forth as she eats one piece of sugar from the palm of Oliver's hand; how she washes her face then flips open her wings to fly away.

Such specificity and presence in the moment are buttressed by her opening and closing, larger than life questions.

I think beginning a new ministry year is like this. Our eyes are upon all that is before use. We are held, perhaps haunted, by all that happened last year.

But ministry is not the large sweeping moments – the rising worship numbers or budget line. The grand view of our ministry is in fact found in the immediate, day-to-day moments.

The way our ministries allow for someone to receive a hug at just the right time is in fact our goal.

The way a child proudly points to her church as she passes by saying, "That's my church" because she knows she is loved and belongs to a people, a place, a God much larger than our everyday.

The way a bible study conversation helps someone feel God's love in a whole new way.

As we begin a brand-new year of ministry together, I pray you know how very precious you are to me and to this church. As we plan, prepare, place dates on calendars, make arrangements, and invite folks to join us; remember these words from Mary Oliver:

I don't know exactly what a prayer is.

I do know how to pay attention, how to fall down into the grass, how to kneel down in the grass, how to be idle and blessed, how to stroll through the fields, which is what I have been doing all day.

Tell me, what else should I have done?

I am grateful for your ministry. I pray you find the kernels of sweetness in this wild and precious journey we share together.
