We hope our new app and online means of communication will just be one more way we can connect with one another.

Realm Connect, located online, and in your smart phone app store, is a new tool we are launching. This will not replace our newsletter or weekly emails.

Every email address in the church has been sent a direct link to the secure Wakonda account. Please follow the link in your email to set up your account, and download the app if you have a smartphone.

This app will serve as a digital directory, easy means of communication amongst groups and ministries, and be a one-stop shop for all your volunteer and service days for deacons, elders, Worship and Wonder, etc.

In this app you can:

- Update your contact information
- Upload a family photo
- Provide next of kin and emergency contact information

We understand not everyone is comfortable with newer technology. The church staff and leadership are also learning this new system – let's learn and connect together. Even if you do not want to use the app, by registering with Realm Connect online, you can have all communications sent directly to your email, so you won't miss a thing!

We're going to take this new technology in stages and will provide support all along the way.

Stage 1: Registering all members. Even if you do not want to utilize this new system, by registering you ensure your contact information is included in the directory.

Support for Stage 1: Sundays, Oct 1, 8, & 15 we'll have our own Wakonda Genius Bar available in the Narthex. During the Sunday school hour our youth and Podcasts with the Pastor Sunday school class will help you download the app and set up your registration. Coffee and donuts also provided, along with a great opportunity to connect with another member of Wakonda.

What you need to bring: Your smartphone (if you have one), your email login and password information. We will not retain this information; we will just use it to retrieve your Realm Connect link.

Stage 2: Training our leaders and setting up our communication groups.

With everyone in the system, we can better set up our ministry groups. These will be our Sunday School classes, Youth and Children's groups, Bible Studies, Choir, Book Clubs, Women's and Men's groups, etc.

We'll also set up our Service Groups. This will be our Elders, Deacons, Worship and Wonder Storytellers and Greeters. Any group where you volunteer on a specific day. This app allows us to have your unique schedule sent directly to your phone.

Phase Two will begin in November in training our leaders in their specific groups. We hope to fully launch this phase with the entire congregation after the first of the year.

Your questions are valuable and your engagement on the app will only improve our connections and communications. Thank you for your participation and patience in getting us more deeply connected.

We hope our new app and online means of communication will just be one more way we can connect with one another.

Realm Connect, located online, and in your smart phone app store, is a new tool we are launching. This will not replace our newsletter or weekly emails.

Every email address in the church has been sent a direct link to the secure Wakonda account. Please follow the link in your email to set up your account, and download the app if you have a smartphone.

This app will serve as a digital directory, easy means of communication amongst groups and ministries, and be a one-stop shop for all your volunteer and service days for deacons, elders, Worship and Wonder, etc.

In this app you can:

- Update your contact information
- Upload a family photo
- Provide next of kin and emergency contact information

We understand not everyone is comfortable with newer technology. The church staff and leadership are also learning this new system – let's learn and connect together. Even if you do not want to use the app, by registering with Realm Connect online, you can have all communications sent directly to your email, so you won't miss a thing!

We're going to take this new technology in stages and will provide support all along the way.

Stage 1: Registering all members. Even if you do not want to utilize this new system, by registering you ensure your contact information is included in the directory.

Support for Stage 1: Sundays, Oct 1, 8, & 15 we'll have our own Wakonda Genius Bar available in the Narthex. During the Sunday school hour our youth and Podcasts with the Pastor Sunday school class will help you download the app and set up your registration. Coffee and donuts also provided, along with a great opportunity to connect with another member of Wakonda.

What you need to bring: Your smartphone (if you have one), your email login and password information. We will not retain this information; we will just use it to retrieve your Realm Connect link.

Stage 2: Training our leaders and setting up our communication groups.

With everyone in the system, we can better set up our ministry groups. These will be our Sunday School classes, Youth and Children's groups, Bible Studies, Choir, Book Clubs, Women's and Men's groups, etc.

We'll also set up our Service Groups. This will be our Elders, Deacons, Worship and Wonder Storytellers and Greeters. Any group where you volunteer on a specific day. This app allows us to have your unique schedule sent directly to your phone.

Phase Two will begin in November in training our leaders in their specific groups. We hope to fully launch this phase with the entire congregation after the first of the year.

Your questions are valuable and your engagement on the app will only improve our connections and communications. Thank you for your participation and patience in getting us more deeply connected.

How can our congregation more deeply connect with one another?

How can we help connect people with our ministries? How can we connect more deeply with God?

These are questions pastors and church leaders ask time, and time again. When someone comes to us lamenting,

"but I didn't know this was happening?" we scratch our heads and wonder how we can do this better. Or our leaders, to the best of their ability, communicate in all the ways possible; and yet, we still miss people.

Connection is what a church is all about. Connection is our forever goal and challenge.

We hope our new app and online means of communication will just be one more way we can connect with one another.

Realm Connect, located online, and in your smart phone app store, is a new tool we are launching. This will not replace our newsletter or weekly emails.

Every email address in the church has been sent a direct link to the secure Wakonda account. Please follow the link in your email to set up your account, and download the app if you have a smartphone.

This app will serve as a digital directory, easy means of communication amongst groups and ministries, and be a one-stop shop for all your volunteer and service days for deacons, elders, Worship and Wonder, etc.

In this app you can:

- Update your contact information
- Upload a family photo
- Provide next of kin and emergency contact information

We understand not everyone is comfortable with newer technology. The church staff and leadership are also learning this new system – let's learn and connect together. Even if you do not want to use the app, by registering with Realm Connect online, you can have all communications sent directly to your email, so you won't miss a thing!

We're going to take this new technology in stages and will provide support all along the way.

Stage 1: Registering all members. Even if you do not want to utilize this new system, by registering you ensure your contact information is included in the directory.

Support for Stage 1: Sundays, Oct 1, 8, & 15 we'll have our own Wakonda Genius Bar available in the Narthex. During the Sunday school hour our youth and Podcasts with the Pastor Sunday school class will help you download the app and set up your registration. Coffee and donuts also provided, along with a great opportunity to connect with another member of Wakonda.

What you need to bring: Your smartphone (if you have one), your email login and password information. We will not retain this information; we will just use it to retrieve your Realm Connect link.

Stage 2: Training our leaders and setting up our communication groups.

With everyone in the system, we can better set up our ministry groups. These will be our Sunday School classes, Youth and Children's groups, Bible Studies, Choir, Book Clubs, Women's and Men's groups, etc.

We'll also set up our Service Groups. This will be our Elders, Deacons, Worship and Wonder Storytellers and Greeters. Any group where you volunteer on a specific day. This app allows us to have your unique schedule sent directly to your phone.

Phase Two will begin in November in training our leaders in their specific groups. We hope to fully launch this phase with the entire congregation after the first of the year.

Your questions are valuable and your engagement on the app will only improve our connections and communications. Thank you for your participation and patience in getting us more deeply connected.


