# **WAKONDA NEWS**

#### From the Pastor's Desk

I've had many different titles in my years of ministry. I've been a Youth and Children's Minister, an Associate Minister (the general catch-all), a Senior Minister, and a Minister of Growth.

This last one was a little bit of a head scratcher. In churches we often focus upon counting the number of folks on our roles, how many baptisms, births, and deaths happen in the year, what the weekly attendance is, how many hospital visits or communion calls were made. We count and measure how we're growing often by these numbers. Those numbers do tell us something. How much communion should we prepare, how many elders do we need as baptism sponsors, as well as when to do baby blessings and fill the baptistry.

But numbers don't tell us the whole story. I used to joke that everything I ever needed to know about ministry I learned as a youth minister. I still stand by this. Most of ministry is best done when you show up for one another, remember that a silly game or song can open us up to experience God, and no matter what you have on hand, it can be made into communion. PB & J or chips and salsa are still some of my all-time favorite communion meals.

But the Minister of Growth title was the one that really challenged me. My whole job was focused not upon the number of folks who joined, or how many members we had, but rather focused upon the depth of our growth as Christians. Our faith is a living part of us — and the ways we tend to it, nurture it, and give it space to grow, determines the size our faith can become.

There are unfortunately many factors outside our control which provide those opportunities for growth. The loss of a job, an illness, the death of a loved one, or a world-wide pandemic. We do not have control of those things – and yet, what we do have control of is how we turn toward God in those moments. Some of my most humbling moments in ministry have been witnessing the ways people respond with compassion, grace, and gentleness in these toughest of moments.

As a church with an active Sunday school program, I know we're committed to the growth of our personal faith. If you're looking to deepen your faith, there is a Sunday morning class, Wednesday morning Bible study, or monthly book study which will happily welcome you into the fold.

But growth also can simply be taking 10 minutes out of your day to pray. Set a timer on your phone and unplug your brain from the world. Take a page out of your work notebook to write a letter to God. Pick up the phone and reconnect with that old friend or family member you haven't spoken to for a long time. Dig in your garden and marvel at the splendor of God's creation. Or if everything is overwhelming right now, pause to pray. And if you fall asleep while doing so, trust that you're falling into a moment of rest with God.

In this season of growth, I pray you'll respond to the invitations God is setting before you to grow.
