Unlike the people who muttered about Zacchaeus, may our children see beyond the lifestyle and behavior of those who respond to the Good News. Like Jesus, may they be loving, kind and gracious.

When our children encounter Jesus, may they, like Zacchaeus, have an instant inward change that is demonstrated by an outward action of faith that testifies of His transforming power.

Like the Good Shepherd, may our children never give up on the one lost sheep and when that one is found, may they joyfully help that person along until they are able to stand on their own and continue their journey.
