A New Song

As an act of praise, may our children sing about the Lord and may a new song come forth from their hearts.

Influences

Holy Spirit, remind our children to be careful about what influences they use to form their opinions so they will not trade the Truth about God for a lie, causing them to worship and serve the created things rather than the Creator.

God's Praise

None Righteous

Father, may all of our children know they cannot stand on their own righteousness because there is no one that is righteous, not even one.

God's Requirement Jesus, help our children to fulfill God's requirement to love their neighbor as themselves.
