We are reading through the Bible chronologically this year. You can read the entire account or just the key verse, then do the activity. You're off to a great start!

MONDAY GENESIS 22-24 KEY VERSE - GENESIS 22:18

God gives Abraham directions to follow one step at a time. Because Abraham loves and trusts God, he does exactly as God says. God doesn't give Abraham all of the steps at one time, because he wants to walk with Abraham along the way to show him He's where the joy is!

God will speak to you through His Word. Read the verse below and write the steps God wants you to take. Remember He is with you as you do!

Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Love him with all your mind." This is the first and most important commandment. And the second is like it. "Love your neighbor as you love yourself."

TUESDAY GENESIS 25-26 KEY VERSE - GENESIS 26:24

WEDNESDAY GENESIS 27-29 KEY VERSE - GENESIS 28:15

God is in control over everything, including the sin we have in our hearts. When Rebekah sins by tricking Isaac, God still uses it to accomplish His plan. God knows all the wrong things you will do, but He's still working through it all.

THURSDAY GENESIS 30-31 KEY VERSE – GENESIS 30:22

God listens to our prayers and is kind to answer. Use the PRAY acronym to talk to God today.

Praise – "Thank You for hearing my prayer. You are kind to me."

Repent – "Forgive me for the wrong things I do. Help me do what is right."

Ask – "Give me _____ if it's what You know is best for me."

Yes – "I want what You want!"

FRIDAY GENESIS 32-34 KEY VERSE – GENESIS 32:10

God draws near to Jacob. He wrestles with him, renames him, and changes him. God often uses hard times to change our hearts too. He's faithful to finish everything He starts.
