

Luke 6:12–13 | MAR 7 | Week ONE BEGIN WITH PRAYER

THE TEXT | Luke 6:12-13; John 15:16; 2 Corinthians 5:17-20; Matthew 28:18-20

PLAY | APPLES TO APPLES | Plan a game night and play a game of Apples to Apples to introduce the idea of being fruitful. Don't have the game? You can find it <u>here.</u>

SHARE | Share about a time when you told someone about Jesus. How did it go? What was the result?

DISCUSS |Read 1 Corinthians 5:17-20 and discuss:

- What stands out to you?
- What does it reveal about God?
- What does this tell us about our nature?
- What do you like/dislike about this verse?
- What do you need to do about this truth this week?

Use the above questions to discuss any of the Scriptures listed at the top of this CUE.

BEGIN WITH PRAYER



- Who do you know that isn't following Jesus?
- What might happen if you share Jesus with then? What might happen if you don't?
- Why is beginning with prayer important?

- 3. How can you PLAN your prayer better?

Be careful not to make this a judgement statement about people's value, but rather, because they are important to you (and Jesus), we want them to know of Jesus' love. Then, write their names in a place your family members will be reminded to pray for them.
