

## LUKE 1:26-38 SURRENDERED

THE TEXT | Luke 1:26-38

**PLAY | RED LIGHT GREEN LIGHT |** To illustrate having control or not having control, play a few rounds of the classic kids game, RED LIGHT/ GREEN LIGHT. **Lesson Lead In:** How did it feel to be in control? How did it feel for someone else to control your actions? Today, we will see how God used a teenaged girl when she gave up control to Him.

#### SHARE I

Share a time when you surrendered, but it was a good thing? What's one situation you always want to be in control?

#### **DISCUSS** | Read LUKE 1:26-38 and discuss:

- What stands out to you?
- What does it reveal about God?
- What does this tell us about our nature?
- What do you like/dislike about this verse?
- What do you need to do about this truth this week?

Use the above questions to discuss any of today's Scriptures.

#### PRAY |

Ask God to lead you as a family to truth; not to rely only on others thoughts on Scripture, but to lead you to be students of God's Word.
