WAYS TO USE THIS CUE

- IN THE CARE | Pick a few questions or quotes to spark
- 1 ON 1 | Take your teen to breakfast use it as a guide
- for discipleship.

THE TEXT | Ephesians 4:1-3; Matthew 11:29; 1 Peter 5:5b; Philippians 2:3; Hebrews 12:2

PLAY | I Like | This game requires sturdy chairs and works best with 8 or more. Sit in a circle, with IT in the center. IT then says I LIKE PEOPLE THAT , filling in the circle with an attribute (examples: are wearing red, have blonde hair, are in 6th grade, etc). Then those to which the statement applies must switch seats while it tries to sit. Whoever is left without a chair becomes it and continues the game.
