



Children's Ministry Intern Job Description

Objective of the Internship

This position exists for the mutual benefit of A&M United Methodist Church and the intern. A&M UMC benefits from an individual who can offer their own set of skills, knowledge, interests, and passions to support and enhance our church as a whole. In turn, the intern receives the opportunity to learn and practice ministry in a safe and nurturing environment as the intern continues to discern a call to ministry.

Profile of the Intern

- Must be at least 19 years of age
- Possessing a sense of call to ministry and desiring a place to follow and process that calling
- Willing to connect and care for the congregation with an emphasis on children and family ministry.
- Ability to help lead all age levels from 0 - 6th grade and group activities
- Must pass a background check and adhere to Safe Sanctuary policy
- Willing to work a maximum of 20 hours a week. (The hours will be flexible.)

Expectations of the Intern

To be an example of Christian health to our children, their families, and all members, involving things like:

- Taking opportunities to grow in your faith personally.
- Attending Sunday morning Sunday School consistently.
- Assisting with Wednesday evening programs for all aged children.
- Assisting with Sunday Evening programs for grades 4 - 6th grade.
- Assisting with Confirmation.
- Living out a Christian walk both in the church and outside the church.

To grow in maturity as a Christian servant and leader:

- Meeting weekly with the Children's Director and Intern Mentor to reflect on ministry principles and evaluating ministry experiences.
- Engage in Christian leadership & discipleship growth that is led by the Children's Director and/or Intern Mentor

To serve as a leader in the A&M UMC Children and Family Ministry and the congregation as a whole:

- Assist with plans and leadership of the Wednesday evening JC Club and L.A.M.B.S. Ministry program.
- Attend and assist with the Sunday morning Sunday school teaching & programs.
- Assist with plans and execution of Children and Family Ministry special events.
- Assist with some administrative tasks with the Children's Director.
- Assist with the Acolyte coordinator.
- Assist with other church related tasks as needed.

The Children's Intern is directly accountable to the Children's Director who works under the Senior Pastor.
