# HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

TO BEGIN JULY 5, DURING PHASE 3



## Logistics for Gatherings:

- Front, side and back parking lots will be available
- When arriving, the only door available to enter through will be the front doors, they will open 30 minutes prior to service time.
- When departing, the only door available to leave through will be the back doors.
- Pre-registration to monitor building capacity
- Gathering will be 60 minutes; leaving 30 minutes between gatherings for transition and cleaning
- Seating at tables to maintain social distancing
- Families smaller than 5 will be able to sit 2 families per table grouping
- Families larger than 5 will sit at one table grouping
- Contactless building entry
- We will ask every person/family to fill out a GenCard with name and number

## Individual Safety:

- Sanitizer will be available throughout the facility
- Face coverings will be available for those who may need them
- Space will be cleaned between gatherings
- Limited refreshments - we recommend bringing your own
- Prepackaged communion will be available
- Family time will be suspended for the time being
- Those who have been sick or are high risk we encourage to stay home and stream online

## Church Functions:

- Gatherings sizes will be within the phased large group regulations
- Pre-registration will be required to manage facility capacity
- No kids classes during Phase 3; activities and coloring sheets will be on tables
- Inform all via posted signage that entering into the facility is an agreement by presence to a hold harmless clause; GenChurch will not be held liable for someone contracting COVID-19

## What we will do:

- Manage facility capacity when guidelines require limited attendance
- Provide face coverings for those who may need them and encourage all to wear them if able
- Ensure protocols are in place to foster a safe and healthy environment
- Recommend those who are sick or at risk to stay home and stream online
- Encourage personal responsibility, mutual respect, and gospel unity.

## What we will not do:

- Report any list of members, guests, visitors, or staff for tracing purposes
- Turn away new visitors or non-registered guests
- Turn away those without masks
- Encourage those in attendance to break social distancing guidelines
- Shame one another concerning matters of conscience
