

## Sunday School Notes

### **August 16, 2020 Joseph Waiting Not Knowing What God was Doing**

Genesis 39:8-40:23 Punished for doing the right thing. Note Matthew 5:10-12; 1 Peter 2:11-12, 18-22; 3:14-17

Examine Potiphar's wife's strategy to incriminate Joseph (Genesis 39:13-18). The "evidence", repeating lies, and playing the race card.

Joseph is more righteous in the sexual realm than his older brothers Reuben (Genesis 35:22) and Judah (Genesis 38:15-18).

The uncertainty of Joseph's waiting. God was with him during his suffering, blessing him wherever he was called. Compare Genesis 39:2-6 and Genesis 39:21-22 and Psalm 1. Joseph did whatever job he was at well. See Genesis 40:6.

What emotional Satanic attacks might have Joseph had to deal with? Genesis 40:14 and Genesis 49:22-24

Joseph was sold into slavery at 17, now he is about 28 when he interprets the cupbearer and bakers dreams.

Why do you think the cupbearer and baker were put in prison?

Genesis 41:1-40 God opens prison doors. Psalm 105:20

Genesis 41:41-57 Joseph as prime minister of Egypt and implementing wisdom learn through his hard journey. Psalm 105:21-22

### **August 9, 2020 Joseph the Patriarch and His Trials and Tests**

Genesis 37:36, Acts 7:9; Psalm 105:17-18;

Genesis 39:1-6 Favor as a slave under Potiphar.

Where did Joseph get his work ethic and integrity from? Genesis 28:20-22; 30:25-33; 31:2-13; 38-42

Genesis 39:7-20a A big test, while life is going good. Proverbs 5:3-4, 8-9; 6:23-29; 7:17-21; Ecclesiastes 7:26; 1 Corinthians 6:18-20

### **August 2, 2020 Joseph the Patriarch and His Trials**

Genesis 37:1-11 Joseph dreams, naivety, and brotherly rivalries

Deuteronomy 29:18-21; Job 36:13-14; Proverbs 19:11; Proverbs 28:14; Hebrews 3:7-19; 4:7; 12:14-15; James 3:14-16

### **July 26, 2020 Abraham's Intercession for Lot and His Family**

Read: Genesis: 18:16-19:29; Genesis 13:5-13; Genesis 14:11-24

Lot and Sodom and Gomorrah 2 Peter 2:6-9; Jude 7

Abraham's faith: Romans 4:18-25; Hebrews 11:8-19; James 2:20-24
