### March 28, 2021

*The second commandment* – You shall not make for yourself an idol (continued).

**A Review of Last Week** Exodus 32:1-8, 15-20; Deuteronomy 9:7-21

**The Explanation and Aftermath:** Exodus 32:21-33:6; see Deuteronomy 13:6-15; (Deuteronomy 33:8-11, especially verse 9 and Malachi 2:4-9); Compare Exodus 32:25-29 to Matthew 10:37, 12:46-48; Mark 3:20-21, 31-35; Luke 8:19-21; 14:26

**Moses' example of re-focusing with God** Exodus 33:7-11

**Moses pouring his heart out to God, and God answering** Exodus 33:12-17

**The result of Moses spending time with God** Exodus 34:29-35 →The foreshadowing of 2 Corinthians 3:7-17

*The third commandment* – You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name. Exodus 20:7 and Deuteronomy 5:11 compare with Leviticus 19:12; 24:10-16, 23; Numbers 30:1-16, especially verse 2; Deuteronomy 6:13; 23:21-23; Ecclesiastes 5:1-7; Matthew 5:33-37; James 5:12

### March 21, 2021

**A few more verses from last week regarding Israel and the Moabites:** Remember Deuteronomy 2:9, 18, 19; Numbers 22:1-6, Judges 11:15-18; Why did the Israelites hold animosity toward the Moabites? Deuteronomy 23:3-6 and Nehemiah 13:1-2

*The second commandment* – You shall not make for yourself an idol. Ex. 20:4-6 and Deut. 5:7-10; Duet. 4:23-24

**Impatience Waiting for Moses, Aaron caving to the crowd:** Exodus 31:18-32:20; Deuteronomy 9:7-21  
The raw materials of the Golden Calf: Genesis 15:14; Exodus 3:21-22; 11:1-3; 12:33-36→ Exodus 32:2-4, 33:4-6

### March 14, 2021

*The first commandment* – You shall have no other gods before me. Ex. 20:1-3 and Deut. 5:6-7;

**No public curses, but devastating advice** Numbers 25:1-9; (1 Corinthians 10:8 compare with Numbers 25:7-9) 2 Peter 2:13-16; Jude 10-11 and Revelation 2:14

**God rewards Phinehas' bold action** Numbers 25:10-13; Deuteronomy 4:1-4; 33:9-10; Psalm 106:28-30;

**God's vengeance on the Midianites** Numbers 31:1-18 Why did the Israelites hold animosity toward the Moabites? Deuteronomy 23:3-6 and Nehemiah 13:1-2 (Remember Deuteronomy 2:9); Joshua 13:22 Balaam's trade and fate.

### March 7, 2021

*The first commandment* – You shall have no other gods before me. The lure of prestige, power, and riches.

**Balaam ignoring circumstances and taking advantage of Balak and Moab's fear.**

**The First Oracle** (Numbers 23:1-12) The expense and expectation of verses 1 and 6, Balaam takes credit for Balak's compare verse 3 and 4. A people who live apart see verse 9. Balaam leading Balak and the princes on verse 10.

**Balaam's Second Oracle** (Numbers 23:13-26) Another location only seeing part of Israel. Again the expense and the expectation to Balak verses 14-15 and 17. How does verses 19-20 to Balaam's life? The fate and strength of Israel verses 21-24. No sorcery against Israel... verse 23. Balak's response verses 25-26.
