1. On Sunday, we looked at the definition of empathy, which is: ***the ability to understand and share the feelings of another.*** How can empathy bring about needed brotherly love in our families, communities, country, and churches?
2. On Sunday, Dan said, ***“our world is becoming a more hate-filled place, where people have less empathy and compassion for others, but Christ-followers are called to live lives of love and harmony.”*** In your mind, why is our world becoming more hate-filled and with less empathy? (**read and discuss Matthew 24:12**) What can Christ-followers do to live lives of love and harmony?
3. **Read 1 Peter 3:8-9.** How can this challenge improve the division and unrest in our communities and country? What role does humility play in the living with love and harmony? What role does empathy play?
4. We took a few minutes on Sunday to discuss what it means to “put yourself in someone else’s shoes.” What is this important? How does this help with empathy and living in love and harmony with others?
5. **Read Hebrews 4:15-16.** How can Jesus be empathetic towards us? How does this comfort you? How does this motivate you to exhibit brotherly love to others in your circle?

*Whenever we read Scripture, or hear a message preached, we should ask ourselves these important questions before walking away:

1. What is God saying to me about this?
2. What will I do about what He is saying to me?
3. How can my church help?
