4. **Read Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 10:9, John 3:16, and Romans 6:23.** How is the message of the Gospel simple? What are some things that Satan uses to complicate the simplicity of the Gospel?
5. On Sunday, we listed 3 things that we could do as individuals to uphold the value of simplicity in our lives:
  - 1.) Say no to the rat race of greed, in order to enjoy the simplicity of contentedness and generosity
  - 2.) Say no to unhealthy expectations of others, in order to say yes to the will of God
  - 3.) Say no to unhealthy activity, in order to rest in your salvation in Christ and live on mission.
