1. On Sunday, it was said that, ***“God is the foundation of the Church and we are the Church, thus God needs to be our foundation.”*** Why is this so important? Does this give you encouragement about the foundation of our church? How so?
2. **Read Exodus 13:17-18.** God always knows best! How does this part of the story help you to trust God in difficult circumstances?
2. **Read Exodus 13:21-22.** The Israelites had 2 very visible reminders that God was with them no matter how off course they felt or how hard life was. What “signs” visible or invisible do you have in your life to remind you of God’s presence and faithfulness?
3. On Sunday, it was said that, ***“God never promised that following Him would be easy.”*** Can I get an amen? You understand how hard life is and how difficult it can be to follow God, but why is it worth it to follow Him? How does this passage give you hope for the future?

7. Keep looking in the Bible for God's promises!
