4. **Read Galatians 4:13-16** Explain Paul’s second plea in this section of scripture: **Remember our past friendship**.
5. **Read Galatians 4:17-20**. Explain Paul’s third plea in this section of scripture: **I am like a spiritual father to you**.
6. In your own words, explain sanctification.
