4. Evaluate the three answers as to why we should pray: Why pray? 1.) Because we are commanded to. 2.) To discover God's will. 3.) To change things. Which answer makes the most sense to you and why? Which answer is the most difficult to understand and why?
5. What factors cause you to struggle with prayer?
