

Paul prays for the church in Colosse. He thanks God for the church and asks God to give the church things they need.

What are you thankful for?

What are some things you need from God?

Verse 16 says: For by Him (Jesus) all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth

Spend some time memorizing this verse over the next few weeks

What are your favorite things in creation?

Because God created everything, He knows how to hold things together, how to fix things that are broken, how to make things better when they go wrong.

What hard things has God helped fix?

What are some situations you are currently facing that you need God's help with?

How does knowing God is the creator of everything help you when you are scared or sad?
