STORYPARK

Storypark is a secure online program where you can follow your child's learning journey to see what they are interested in while they are at Just Kids. It helps connect you with your child's teachers to ensure they receive the best opportunities in their early years. WHY CHOOSE JUST KIDS HOUSE?

At Just Kids House we provide an inclusive learning environment that supports children to grow and develop social and emotional competency. Our kaiako encourage our children to, participate, explore and extend in their own learning. Our learning environment recognises the value of ako, where children of all ages learn alongside, with and from each other (tuakana-teina).

We support families through building strong relationships, having an open-door policy, seeking parent aspirations for their child and working to realise those aspirations within the daily program. We support whānau by running parent evenings at night and parent hui during the day. We have our own publication "*For Under Fives*" which has information, tips and advice for parents on child development and how to support children in their early years.

We provide morning and afternoon tea each day. Our menu changes on a regular basis and we ensure that children eat a balanced and nutritious morning tea for sustained energy.

We have a free transport service which supports families to ensure their child is able to attend preschool regularly.

We are passionate about seeing children develop in their oral language and communication skills. We invest in this by being a part of the Duffy Book Program which ensures children receive free books throughout the year.

In short, we are committed to our community, the children in our care and their families and we invite you to join us!
