Cambodia – Pray with the Cambodian Team for God's continued mercy over 900 Cambodians in Phnom Penh who were recently exposed to a Norwegian dignitary who tested positive for COVID-19. Among those who interacted with this dignitary is the Prime Minister himself, along with several members of his parliamentary cabinet. Those exposed have been asked to self-isolate, face masks are popular again and schools, gyms, bars, cinemas have been closed for two weeks as preventative measures.

Silk Road – Pray with Dave and Becky as they provide leadership and pastoral care to the international church during constantly changing COVID-19 restrictions. Pray for the budget issues as wisdom is needed to know where to apply funds. Pray for the many in need financially, emotionally, and spiritually under Dave and Becky's care.

Sea to Sea – Pray with New Venture Implementer Bill Morrison who oversees new things happening in Atlantic Canada. During COVID-19, he and his wife Louise are praying for a group of student leaders who will work with them in developing some online house church and Bible study opportunities for international students.

Silk Road – Pray for Basma, a woman who is part of a small local believing home church whose son and daughter are being held in prison for three years for a crime they did not commit—the arrest happening right after her daughter was baptized. Praise God for three new followers of Christ that recently joined their group.

Guinea – Pray with Colette for protection and perseverance for the Renaissance radio, as there have been a few instances of lawlessness. The main leader of the radio station had a motorcycle accident and has a broken wrist. Three other employees have been robbed on the street in the past month. Colette and the Renaissance radio employees continue to praise God that the Good News is being broadcast and many people are coming to Jesus.

Silk Road – Pray with Caitlyn as she seeks to meet the needs of those God puts in her path. Pray for Katrina who has undergone her last surgery and will hopefully return home in a few weeks. Pray for Hannah who broke her leg weeks ago and needed treatment that Caitlyn was able to help set up. Pray that the regular follow up visits Caitlyn makes to this family will open up spiritual conversations.
