



CONTINENT WHERE THE GOSPEL CONTINUES TO SPREAD

Africa: a continent of staggering beauty and resilience that has weathered colonialism, conflict, and change while maintaining vibrant, diverse cultures. From the rust-colored dunes of the Sahara to the emerald highlands of Ethiopia, it's a land where approximately 3,792 distinct people groups (counted per country) call home, and where the gospel continues to write some of its most dramatic chapters.

Yet across the northern reaches of this vast continent stretches what mission strategists have long called the "Green Belt," not for its vegetation, but for the color of Islam. From Mauritania's Atlantic shores to the Horn of Africa, this swath of predominantly Muslim communities represents one of the most significant spiritual frontiers of our generation. Here, the call to prayer echoes five times daily across cities and villages, and for many, the name of Jesus remains distant.

The numbers tell a sobering story: 529 Frontier People Groups exist across Africa, communities with almost no Christian presence or access to the gospel in their heart language. Of these, 491 are Islamic. That's 93% of Africa's least-reached peoples living under the crescent moon's shadow.

The five largest deserve our attention and our prayers:

- *Algerian Arabic-speakers in Algeria: 34.4 million people
- *Moroccan Arabs in Morocco: 25.7 million people
- *Sudanese Arabs in Sudan: 15.9 million people
- *Somali in Somalia: 14.9 million people
- *Wolof in Senegal: 6.3 million people

These aren't just statistics. They're mothers and merchants, students and farmers, people created in God's image, loved with an everlasting love, yet living beyond the reach of the good news.

The story continues. And your prayers, your gifts, your going: they're all part of how God is writing the next chapter among Africa's 529 frontier people groups.
