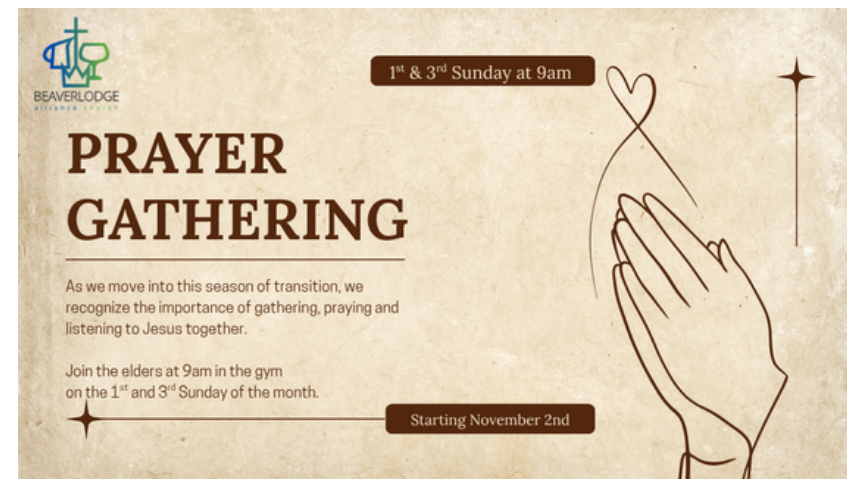

Japan—Pray with Joze as he continues serving with Sidewalk Chapel (in partnership with Kokoro Care and Overseas Missionary Fellowship) and exploring new ways to connect with Japanese men through apps and meetup groups. Pray for discernment for him and the team as they pursue opportunities aligned with their strategy of building intentional relationships, sharing the Good News, equipping others, and partnering together.

Least-Reached People Group Focus: The Moken People—The Moken people are a nomadic people from Myanmar and Southern Thailand. They depend on the sea and are also referred to as the Sea Gypsies. Some Moken people follow Buddhism, while others adhere to traditional religions. Pray for opportunities for Christians to reach the Moken people with the gospel message and that their hearts will be receptive to the message.

Japan—Pray with Jacob and Christina as their family continues adjusting to life in Japan. As they begin a new rhythm with language studies, pray for them to have open eyes to see the culture around them and to recognize the redemptive work of King Jesus woven throughout the people and places they encounter.

Thailand—Please pray for the team in Hat Yai, Southern Thailand. Pray for Derik & Bonnie Burnett and their neighbours, as the first floor of their homes has flooded. Pray for their safe evacuation, for those who are stranded, and for protection during this difficult time. Also, pray for opportunities to share the hope and peace of Christ with those who are feeling despair.

International Workers—Pray for our International Workers as we move into the holiday season. Ask that, wherever they are serving, they will experience deep joy, meaningful community, and God's reassuring presence.
