

Japan—Pray with the Japan team that as ambassadors of King Jesus, they would continue to learn about Japanese culture with reverence, curiosity, and courage. As they learn the stories Japan has carried for generations, pray for wisdom and opportunities to share the story that carries us, the compassionate and just reign of Jesus, who invites every nation into hope.

Children of International Workers—Pray for children who struggle to spend holidays like Christmas, Easter, and Thanksgiving away from their extended family, whom they miss. Pray for them during these special times of celebration when they may be feeling homesick. Pray for God to grant them meaningful celebrations with a loving community where they are living.

Senegal—Pray with Keith Haensel for the group of homeless boys he is working with as they build a chicken coop at a drop-in center in Dakar, Senegal. Some of these boys are Fulani, yet currently there are no workers who speak Pulaar with them. Pray that Keith would be able to grow in his Pulaar skills and that these boys would see the love of Jesus through this center as they develop different life skills.

Asia—Pray with Caleb and Ruby as they are in the last stretch of translating the member care training curriculum. Pray that they would have clear guidance and wisdom from the Lord for the best ways to express the concepts in the curriculum. Pray also that this will be an anointed tool for the local church, sending agencies, and member care providers to be further equipped and mobilized in their role of caring for international workers from their country.

Niger—Pray with Keith and Melanie Haensel for the creation of a Fulani Ministry Centre in Niger. There are many details currently being worked out in the development of this space, where Fulani believers will be able to come together for prayer and Bible study. It will also be a safe community space for people to go and learn trades while hearing about Jesus.

Poland/Ukraine—Join Don and Betty in praying for an end to the war in Ukraine and those experiencing trauma and loss, including separation from and loss of loved ones. Praise God that a Ukrainian church in Poland has found a place to meet. Praise Him for their engagement and the great work of Radek with the Good Works Ministry through local Polish churches, which supports relief efforts for those in need.
