

It is with great pleasure that we announce we will be gathering physically together again in our sanctuary for worship services! With that in mind, Pastor Mark, and the board members, in conjunction with CDC guidelines and advice from local and district resources have implemented the following safety precautions and procedures for worship services

SERVICE TIME: Sunday August 23, 2020 Worship Service will begin, at 10 AM.

SUNDAY SCHOOL: We will not be holding Sunday School in the church building at this time.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: Social distancing guidelines are to be used by all members and visitors. Please try to maintain at least six feet between you and your neighbor.

FACE MASKS: We recommend that masks be worn by everyone in attendance when entering, leaving, moving around the building, or talking with your neighbors. While seated for the service, they may be removed. We will have masks available for whomever needs one.

ENTER THROUGH FRONT DOORS: When entering the building, please use the front/main doors only. This is to keep walking traffic to a minimum and limit the areas of contact.

HAND SANITIZER: Hand sanitizer will be placed at each entrance door. Please use it often to reduce the chance of viral contamination.

SEATING – EVERY OTHER PEW: Seating will be limited to every other pew to insure proper social distancing. Families may sit together in those available pews.

SINGING: We will have singing unto the Lord.

TITHES & OFFERING: Tithes & offerings will be collected in the "Alabaster" Church placed in the back of the sanctuary. Please place your tithes and offerings in it. They will be collected at the end of service. We will not be passing the offering plates during service. Also, you have the option to pay online on our website **norwinnaz.com** it is located top right of the page under "**Giving**".

The main concern of the Pastor, and the Board, is that it is safe to gather again physically inside the church building. Please, if you are not feeling well, stay home. If you just do not feel safe, stay home. We do not want anyone to feel they have to put themselves at risk. The services will continue to be streamed on the church's YouTube channel and through Facebook live. We cannot wait to be back with you in communal worship to the Lord!
