

FROM SUNDAY SPECTATOR TO THRIVING DISCIPLE



What Are Life Groups?

Life Groups aren't just another church meeting or bible study, they're where life and faith come together.

At The Log Church, we know that true faith grows best not just in rows, but in circles.

Life Groups are small groups of 5-12 members who meet regularly to grow in their faith and support each other's journey.

Rooted deeply in Scripture, Life Groups are our way of living out our mission: 'New World. Same Mission. Win One More.'"

Why Life Groups?

Life Groups serve as the CORE method for executing the church's mission of bringing people to Christ by developing committed disciples who multiply their faith.

JESUS SHOWED THE WAY

Jesus didn't primarily minister through large events; instead, He intentionally invested in a small group of disciples. His example gives us a clear blueprint for relational growth, servant leadership, and multiplication.

Jesus Modeled Intentional, Relational Discipleship

Jesus prioritized personal relationships. He chose the Twelve specifically to spend time closely with Him, as described in Mark:

"And he appointed twelve (whom he also named apostles) so that they might be with him and he might send them out to preach." (Mark 3:14 ESV)

Notice the priority — "that they might be with him." Discipleship is inherently relational. Jesus didn't merely teach theology; He modeled it through shared life.

Jesus Prepared Disciples for Service Through Hands-on Ministry

Jesus intentionally prepared His disciples by giving them practical ministry experiences. He sent them out in pairs to serve and preach, then gathered them back for reflection and encouragement:



"After this the Lord appointed seventytwo others and sent them two by two... The seventy-two returned with joy." (Luke 10:1, 17 ESV)

Life Groups can similarly function as a training ground where members are prepared and sent out to minister together.

Jesus Commanded Multiplication

Jesus' final command, the Great Commission, clearly emphasized multiplication and reproduction of disciples:

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations... teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." (Matthew 28:19-20 ESV)

Life Groups are uniquely positioned to fulfill this mandate by continually training new leaders, reproducing groups, and

fostering discipleship through personal relationships.

Jesus Modeled Humble, Sacrificial Community

Jesus provided a profound model of humility and sacrificial love, especially when He washed His disciples' feet:

"If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet... By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:14, 35 ESV)

Life Groups follow Jesus by practicing humble service and loving one another through tangible acts of care.

Getting Started



While not necessary, we recommend those interested in a Life Group start their journey in the highly successful Rooted program.

Is Rooted For Me?

Rooted is a 10-week discipleship program created to help participants deepen their relationship with God, strengthen their connection to the Church, and discover their purpose.

Whether you are new to the Log Church or a longtime member, we highly recommend you start your Life Group journey in the Rooted program. You'll not only experience many of the same Spiritual Rhythms, but you will build bonds that can naturally turn into a Life Group when Rooted is over.

Since we run Rooted twice a year, in the spring and fall, you may not want to wait to get involved in a Life Group.
