Parent Letter

Dear Parents,

I am so excited to tell you about Student Camp 2026. This letter is for (a) parents whose student is already registered for camp, or (b) parents who would like to learn more about camp before registering their student.

This letter's purpose is to give you as a parent an understanding of what this weekend consists of and also what is expected out of you and your student(s). We will be traveling along with Eastaboga Baptist Church, Iron City Baptist Church, Gilliam Springs Baptist Church, MeadowBrook Baptist Church, and Macedonia Baptist Church, to CampToKnowHim (11115 Co Rd 88, Pisgah, AL 35765). Our theme verse for camp is James 1:22. Below is a short summary of our weekend to help inform you as parents as much as possible to eliminate confusion or worry.

Camp will be **June 12-15**. We will be leaving from Southside Baptist Church at **12:00 P.M.**, so please make sure your student arrives at **11:30 A.M.** This gives us enough time to load everything onto the vehicles. Please bring your student(s) to the **commons (back corner of the church)**, and please come inside to verify that your student has all of the paperwork they need for camp. We will not be stopping for lunch so make sure they eat before they come or pack a snack for the road. We should arrive at camp around **1:30 P.M.** Once at camp we will have free time and lake time until dinner. After dinner we will have worship and small groups.

Saturday and Sunday will largely be the same. These days we will be outside majority of the day so make sure your student(s) pack sunscreen. Closed-toed shoes are also required for a majority of these days. The full packing list is included in the full parent packet. After dinner we will have worship, small groups, then awards.

Monday we will wake up, eat breakfast, have quiet time, clean up the camp, and then head home. We will check out at 9:00 A.M. That puts us **returning to SBC around 10:30 A.M.** We love your student(s), but please be there on time to pick them up when we get back!

Thank you parents once again for entrusting us with your student(s) for the weekend. Our hope is that our students will grow closer to Christ and one another throughout this weekend. If you have any question feel free to contact me.
