Mission Statement: Little Lambs ministry serves partners and guests ages birth through 4 years old. Our goal is to provide a loving and safe environment for children to play and be cared for while their parents or caregivers listen and learn about God's Word.

Description: The Little Lambs team serves to help families during church services. The person or people serving in Little Lambs care for, play with, and keep children safe while parents or caregivers attend the church.

Qualifications:

- Enjoys working with children
- Responsible and dependable
- Friendly and caring

Responsibilities:

1. Serve at scheduled services
2. Arrive 10-15 minutes prior to service starting to open up the nursery
 - a. Door open and lights on
 - b. Sign in/out Binder out
 - c. Turn sign to open
 - d. Make sure pagers are available
 - e. Greet families
3. Maintain a safe and clean environment
 - a. Spray and wipe down tables at the end of service
 - b. Place any toys that were placed in a child's mouth or got dirty in the "ick bucket"
 - c. If needed, vacuum room
 - d. Help children put toys back/clean up room at end of service
4. Wear a "Happy to Help" shirt and/or lanyard with name written on it

Time Commitment:

- 1-1.5 hours; 1 service per month, more if you choose
