Description: Soul Café Volunteer

Qualifications:

- Ages 16 and up. If under the age of 18 must serve with an adult. Adults may work independently.
- The Soul Café volunteer should be comfortable interacting with people who are attending worship and be able to independently fulfill what needs to be accomplished without prompts.

Responsibilities:

- Start brewing coffee at 8:00 a.m.
- Fill all containers with creamers, snacks, & napkins. Refill as needed.
- Serve cappuccino, water and juice, make loose leaf tea in bags
- Greet people and make small talk in a friendly manner.

Time Commitment:

- 8:00 am-10:45 am Sundays.

Relationships: Soul Café volunteers are a vital part of St. Mark Ministries, serving all who attend our Sunday morning worship services to make them feel welcomed and to attend to their need for a good cup of morning coffee/tea/treats. Volunteers will work with Lydia who manages the café and who is under the tier of Jeff Lanier, Operations Manager. If any questions arise while working, volunteers should please contact Lydia. Training: Please train at least one Sunday morning with Lydia Parlow, or as many as needed to feel comfortable. After training the volunteer may work alone or with a family member as long as they are above the required age. (Please no children under 16 years.)
