  - How did you break the sex topic with your family?
  - Pick your own

**Leader Notes:**

- **BIBLE STUDY:** You **DO NOT** need to cover all questions. The idea is to cement the concepts in the sermon by diving deeper into the biblical truths conveyed. Relationships are key in a Life Group!

**Scripture References:** John 1:14; John 8:11; Genesis 2:24; Matthew 19:4-6; 1 Cor 6:19-20; 1 Cor 6:18; Hebrews 13:4; 1 Cor 6:9; 1 Thes 4:4-8; 1 Thes 4:7-8; Galatians 5:1; Galatians 2:20;

**Note to Facilitator:**

These questions will be useful to set the tone for the discussion. Personal story sharing and conversation between people are far more important than covering questions.

**Questions:**

- Why do you think God put only one combination of relationship for people to enjoy sex with God's blessing?
- What sort of guard rails do you have in place to protect your covenant with your God?
- What sort of guard rails do you have in place to protect your covenant with your spouse?
- How would you lovingly approach a Christian brother or sister who you knew was engaged in an inappropriate relationship?
- Sex sells everything from care to cheeseburgers and we are marketed that every day. How do you and your family combat that onslaught?
- What sort of prayers do you engage in regularly for your purity and the purity of your family?
- Talking sex is difficult and many parents use avoidance... why is this so harmful to our kids?

**Leader Notes:**

- Challenge the group to apply the learnings of God's word and the sermon in their lives
  - What sort of thought sins commonly plague you? How do you combat them?
- Ensure Next Meeting Time/Date is mutually understood and agreed upon
