DISCOVER MORE OF WHO GOD IS

In the beginning, God created the heavens

GENESIS 1:1

There is none holy like the LORD: for there is none besides you; there is no rock like our God.

1 SAMUEL 2:2

I love you, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. I call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised..."

DAY THREE

PAUSE TO HEAR GOD SPEAK

And he said, 'Go out and stand on the mount before the LORD.' DAY SEVEN

PRACTICE GENEROSITY

One gives freely, yet grows all the richer; another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want. Whoever brings blessing will be enriched, and one who waters will himself be watered.

PROVERBS 11:24-25

Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal, but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

MATTHEW 6:19-21

Father, I admit I often am anxious about money and providing for my family. It is so easy to think I can't afford to be generous with what You've given me.

I want to be a good steward of Your blessings. So, today I ask for wisdom in how to use my time, treasure, and talents. Realizing you cannot fill a closed hand, I open my hands, giving all I have back to You; and I ask You to continue to fill them as I keep giving it away.

DAY FOURTEEN

GROW IN FAITH

And Jesus answered them, 'Truly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what has been done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' it will happen. And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have faith.

MATTHEW 21:21-22

...All things are possible for one who believes.

MARK 9:23

Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us,

EPHESIANS 3:20

Oh Father, I confess my prayers are often way too small. Without realizing it, I tend to pray for things I feel are "doable"; but these kinds of prayers do not require a lot of faith. Perhaps they are simply "safe prayers".

Today I ask You to "help my unbelief" (Mark 9:24), with no doubting. You are more than able to do far above anything I can even think to ask! Give me courage to pray BOLD prayers – prayers that require total dependence on you, prayers that if You don't come through all is lost. Give me the kind of faith that will move mountains!

DAY FIFTEEN

OAKWOOD IS CHRIST-CENTERED

And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.

COLOSSIANS 1:17-18

that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith – that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

Lord Jesus, our feeble minds cannot grasp all the weight that the words "in Christ" carry. You alone are the center of life itself! And yet, we so easily get off-track listening to our own thoughts and opinions of others.

DAY SIXTEEN

But he [Jesus] answered. 'It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God

MATTHEW 4:4

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God

COLOSSIANS 3:16

Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

ROMANS 12:2

Father God, You spoke the whole world into being. Your Word alone has power to bring life, love, cleansing, healing, freedom, peace, wholeness, knowledge, wisdom, and discernment. Your word has proven true and it will stand forever.

Yet, there are so many voices around us. Everyone wants to be heard. But the truth is only You have the words of eternal life. OAKWOOD REMAINS PRAYER DEPENDENT

Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.

COLOSSIANS 4:2-6

praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication...for all the saints, and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel,

EPHESIANS 6:18-19

Father God, knowing that no one can come to Jesus unless You draw them (John 6:44), I ask you to begin now to hover over the hearts and minds of those who do not know you making them more attentive to spiritual things. I pray that as we engage outsiders we will make Your truth unforgettable, and they will be so intrigued by our lives that they begin to seek You.

I pray for wisdom and discernment, as a believer, to not be so focused on my little life and neglect the eternal fate of someone right in front of me. Give me words to say and boldness to share the good news of a Great Savior!

DAY TWENTY-ONE

THOSE WHO HAVE NEVER HEARD

For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?

ROMANS 10:13-14

Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, 'Brothers, what shall we do?' And Peter said to them, 'Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'

ACTS 2:37-38

Lord Jesus, It's hard to imagine that there are many people who have never heard of You. How will they hear? How will they know?

Today, I ask that You open our eyes to see the harvest before us. Whether we send or train missionaries, fund Scripture translation in other languages, or some other way we've yet to entertain, give us insight into how we can reach people with language, cultural and even logistic barriers.
