## About Honduras...

Located in Central America, Guatemala is to the north, El Salvador is to the west, Nicaragua is to the south, and the Caribbean Sea is to the east.

Tegucigalpa is the capitol city, and Spanish is the primary language.

Per capita income is about \$3200, making it one of the poorest countries in the western hemisphere.

Poverty in Honduras is widespread, affecting over half the population, driven by economic inequality, limited access to services, violence, corruption and natural disasters.

Choluteca is in southern Honduras, near the Pacific coast, about a 3 hour drive from the capitol and the airport. It is the poorest province in all of Honduras, and it experiences high heat and humidity year round.

We will be working with Asten & Vilma Hull and Servants of the King Ministries.

Honduras is a developing country, and there are certainly no guarantees of safety, but we have always experienced a welcoming environment.



## What will we do?

- Luis and Daisy offer Christ-centered rehabilitation to those facing addiction. They will relocate their facilities in order to keep up with demand. The first step in this project is building a large wall to keep those seeking treatment safe.
- Bible School in Local Public Elementary Schools
- "Rice & Beans" Evangelism
- Ministry at an Orphanage and/or Rehab Center and/or Hospital Ministry

## Requirements

- Team members **MUST** be active partners of ChristWay who are at least 14 years old (minors must travel with a parent/guardian).
- Everyone must be physically able to manage two 50-pound suitcases, to withstand **extremely long days** in high temperatures, climb steps & walk on uneven surfaces without assistance.
- You must have a passport with the expiration date being at least 6 months after our trip or you must apply for one within the week of registering for this trip.
- You **MUST** participate in pre-trip team preparations where we will prepare for the mission. There will be some online assignments, and you must attend the team meeting at 12:15 on **April 26**.

## Details

- We will meet at ChristWay on the morning of departure and travel to the airport in Atlanta together. We will fly to Comayagua via United Airlines. Everyone on the team will be expected to travel together. Within Honduras, we will travel by rented trucks with our own experienced teammates driving.
- We'll stay at Aparthotel Las Brisas in Choluteca. It's a modest, local hotel where there will be 2-4 people per room. There is air conditioning and a private bathroom with hot water. Expect a basic but clean and safe room
- The hotel provides a small breakfast, but you are encouraged to also take some of your own breakfast items for the mornings (granola bars, etc.) We will have a sandwich picnic lunch each day at our job sites and then our evening meals will be eaten at either the hotel or local restaurants known to be safe for Americans.
- It's hot!! And it will be rainy season.
- While tap water is not safe for consumption, we will provide plenty of bottled water to keep you hydrated.
- You do not need to know Spanish as we will have translators, but learning a few key phrases would be a great asset!
- Everyone will be expected to learn a worship song in Spanish, to personally share the gospel and to be willing to be part of all team activities.

- The trip cost covers all transportation, hotel, material lunch every day, water, translators and some evening meals.
- Please read the "Mission Team Guidelines" VERY carefully before you sign up because there are very important things you should know regarding payments. All payments are non-refundable!
- Payments must be done at Connection Central or the church office during business hours.
- We strongly prefer a check (but do not put your name on the "for" line or it will not be considered tax-deductible). If you must pay with a card, please add 3% to your payment to cover the card fees.
