1 Timothy 6:6-10, 17-19

This the concluding teaching in the *Where Your Treasure Is* series both warned of the false teaching of what is oft called "the prosperity gospel," and highlighted Paul's excellent word (to Timothy) about the wealth of contented godliness making possible a wealth of generosity.
