2021 READING PLAN

An effective discipleship strategy is not based on a curriculum or program. Effective discipleship strategies are based on intentional relationships, centered around the Word of God, with the purpose of seeing every person mature in Christ (Col. 1:28).

It is our hope that we will journey together in the scriptures this year. Mature disciples read, meditate on, memorize, and apply the Word. They pray for one another and the lost, living life on mission for God's glory. With this thought in mind, it is our heart that the people of Cowee would engage and apply the scriptures in a greater way than ever before.

The Bible reading plan you hold in your hand is a part of that plan. We encourage you to join in reading the scriptures in 2021. Don't just simply read them - engage in them, and apply them to your life. We will be sharing the reading plan in segments this year to allow easy entry points for those new to our church or that would like to start at any time during the year. There are also digital versions of each plan with video devotionals and the ability to share comments with others in our church who are reading along as well. Keeping a journal as you read is a great way to enhance your Bible engagement. An example of a simple method of journaling is found in the HEAR method below.

HIGHLIGHT

Select a passage of scripture to read; this can be 3 - 5 verses, or an entire chapter. As you read the passage, highlight, underline, or jot down the verses that stick out to you.

EXPLAIN

Now explain what the verses mean within the context of the passage. A few questions you can ask yourself are - Why and to whom was this written? How does it fit in with the verses before and after it? What is the writer intending to communicate in this text?

APPLY

This bridges the gap from biblical times to your world today. Remember, there is one interpretation, but many applications. Ask yourself - What would it look like to apply this to my life today? What is God communicating to me here? Think of specific areas in your life where you can apply the text.

RESPOND

This is the part where you respond to God in prayer about the passage you read. Take a few minutes to ask God for help in applying the things you just read and wrote about.

MEMORY VERSES

Romans 3:10 as it is written, “THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned—

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;
