### Questions to ponder, pray over, and discuss...

1. Read Luke 17:11-19. What stands out to you? What moves you? What is difficult to understand?
2. When is it easiest for you to praise God? Where are you drawn to an attitude of praise?
3. When is it hardest for you to praise God? What keeps you from praising Him?
4. Do you have a hard time making requests of God? Why or why not?
5. The lepers, in asking, recognized God's AUTHORITY and believed in His ABILITY. Which of these is easier for you to do? Which is harder? Why?
6. Share a time where it was hard for you to obediently wait on God's timing. What got you through that time? If you're in the midst of that time right now, what keeps you going? Or are you ready to be done? If you're in the midst of that time right now, please pause and let others pray for you RIGHT NOW.
7. What holds you back from recognizing what God is doing in your life? What blinders get in your way? What do/should you do to recognize what God is doing?
8. Read Matthew 25:14-30. What does this teach you about HUMBLE THANKS? To where should all the credit go? Is there any reason we should get any credit for what we do? Why or why not?
9. What ways do you show your gratitude to God? What's one way you should show Him gratitude once the shelter in place is lifted? Keep each other accountable to follow through on this.
10. Who in your life could you never imagine praising God? What are you going to do this week to reach out to that person?
11. Praise God out loud for what He has done, what He is doing, and for all He has given you.
