His sacrifice. Our freedom.

Today we'll be celebrating communion, also called the Lord's Supper. It is one of two visible signs (the other being baptism) that Jesus left for all of his followers to practice as a means of remembering his Grace. He instituted this the night he was arrested and told his followers to "do this in remembrance of me." In celebrating communion, we remember the body and blood of Jesus which was sacrificed so that the penalty for sins would be paid in full, thereby paving the way to be in fellowship with a holy God.
