Questions for the Community

- 1. After reviewing the notes and sermon, what stood out to you as most important, insightful, controversial, etc. Why?

- 6. Pray together as a couple that your sex life would be worship and life giving to your marriage. If you are unmarried, pray for this and prep for it by worshipping God now with your body (including your mind).
