Questions to ponder, pray over, and discuss...

1. Read Luke 10:25-37. What stands out to you? What moves you? What is difficult to understand?

3. When was a time where you tested God? How did He respond? Where did He take you and the situation?
4. How do you live out Luke 10:27? What does it look like to love God with everything you've got and then some?
5. Have there been times when you've tried to qualify God's commandments?
6. Have you lived the part of the man beaten up? Have you lived the part of the robbers? The part of the priest or the Levite? Have you lived the part of the Samaritan? Share how you can identify with each of the characters in the story.
7. Why doesn't Jesus answer the lawyer's second question (and who is my neighbor?)?
8. What is one way you are going to change your ACTIONS based on this passage? What is one way you are going to change your ATTITUDE based on this passage?
9. BONUS: Read Ephesians 3:14-4:6. How does this instruct on the balance of actions and attitude in the Christian's walk? What are some other passages that speak to this?
