### Questions to ponder, pray over, and discuss...

1. Take some time as a group to reflect on the series through Jeremiah. What did you learn? What did you learn about God our Father? How do you want to live differently? Did the series give you a new appreciation for Scripture? What was a favorite passage or story?
2. Which of the four themes of Jeremiah (lament, faithfulness, judgment, hope) do you feel you're living in right now? What have you learned from each of the four about yourself? About God?
3. The people of Judah gained confidence in Jeremiah's prophecies by seeing them come true. What promises of God have you seen come true in your life? How do these experiences give you more confidence in God?
4. Think of a time in your life where it was difficult to believe there is a reason to hope. What glimmers of hope did God give you in the midst of that time? Maybe you're in the midst of that time right now - what hope have you seen or are you seeing that is sustaining you?
5. Read Psalm 22. How does David find hope in the midst of the trial he's going through?
6. When did you first give your life over to Jesus? How has that changed your life? For those that haven't yet trusted Jesus, what is holding you back?
7. Read Jeremiah 31:31-34. Spend some time praising God for the new covenant that He promised hundreds of years before Jesus came!
8. Do you think Jeremiah fully understood the gospel he was prophesying? If not, what does that teach you about his faithfulness? What does that teach you about obedience?
