PERSONAL REFLECTION

1. Are you settling for "good enough" in your relationship with Jesus? Or are you pursuing something greater?
2. When have you been thrust into doing something for God you didn't want to do? How did you respond? How did God use that situation for His glory?

GROUP DISCUSSION

3. Read Luke 23:26-38. What stands out to you? What spurs you on to action? What do you want to study more? Write these things down and pursue them!
4. How has carrying your cross looked in your life? When was it hardest to be obedient? What benefits or blessings have you seen from carrying your cross?
5. When was a time you realized there was something about God you misunderstood? How did that clarity change your understanding of God?
6. Read verse 34. Have you felt like Jesus has said this regarding you? When? Could He say this regarding Christians, or should those in Christ "know better"?
7. When did you first understand that Jesus is the King of the Jews? What does that mean to you today?

PLAN OF ACTION

8. Spend time sitting in the forgiveness of Jesus. Look up some verses on how He has forgiven you. Take some time in thankful prayer, either on your own or as a group.
9. How often do you reflect on the price paid for your salvation? Take some time to study or research crucifixion, or share what you know with someone else. Grieve, knowing that you should have had to pay that price. Then celebrate, thanking Jesus for taking your place.
