Questions for the Community

Devoted to Learning

- 1. Re-read Paul's prayer in Philippians 1:9-11. Why do you think he is praying this for them? Have you ever had someone pray like this for you?
- 2. Feelings and intellect are not enemies or polar opposites but designed by God for good. How is the word (and therefor the idea) of *love* used UN-Biblically? What results have come from defining love however we choose?
- 3. How does one obey and fulfill the prayer in these verses (9-11)? What specifically has that looked like in you or someone you know?

- 4. Share with the person next to you if you are more of a 'thinker' or a 'feeler'. How is this a great strength for you? Why is it a struggle?
- 5. Tell of a time you were steered wrong because feelings were lying to you. How did you see the error? What did you do to correct it?
- Review the 2 action points from Sunday and re-read those verses. Which lands hardest and what action comes with it? (this may be renewed desire to continue in what you are doing or course correct)
