# **Questions** for the **Community**

#### **Personal Reflection**

- 1. Can you remember a time you thought you knew the truth only to discover later you didn't?
- 2. How would you describe your relationship with truth: skeptical, selective, submissive?

#### **Group Discussion**

- 3. Re-read the passage from Sunday. Why is it important that truth is revealed, not just discovered?
- 4. What's the difference between having access to the truth and receiving it?
- 5. How have you seen truth be concealed or misunderstood, even when clearly presented?
- 6. Can you think of an example in your life or someone else's where "knowing" truth didn't lead to transformation? What would Jesus' remedy be to this?

### **Plan of Action**

- 7. "Truth must be trusted with our lives." Where are you tempted to treat truth like a suggestion rather than a foundation?
- 8. In what area of your life do you need the Word to "sanctify" (set apart) you right now?
- 9. Ask the Spirit to reveal truth to each person in a fresh way. Pray for unity, protection, joy, and cooperation to being set apart in truth.
